Documentation

A fully-illustrated user manual is available in the “Documentation” folder.

Please ensure that you read the “First Steps” chapter if you are new to WordPress and the JustLanded theme.

Installation

Please install the justlanded.zip file. It contains the installable WordPress theme. Do not attempt to upload the entire archive as downloaded from themeforest.

The theme can be installed like any other premium theme for the WordPress platform, by uploading the theme's installation zip file, or by copying its contents into the/wp-content/themes/ folder.

Please refer to the manual for further, detailed instructions.

Please make sure that you create a backup of your WordPress installation and its database prior to the theme's installation if your website already contains contents.

Please keep in mind that in order to use the theme's actual landing page features, you will have to create at least one landing page, and select the 'Landing Page' template for that new page. If you are using the demo data, you can skip this step.

Updates

In case you are upgrading from an earlier version of JustLanded for WordPress, please follow the user manual's update instructions (chapter 1.2 “Updates”).

If you are updating from version 1.2.0 or higher, you can use the automatic update feature. However, since themeforest does not operate an update server, you will need to obtain a free license key through registration at <http://ssl.shapingrain.com/register> first. If no valid license key is present, you will still receive update notifications, but no automatic update will be possible. The user manual

contains further instructions.

Please make sure that you create a backup of your WordPress installation and its database prior to installing the update.

Demo Data

Please refer to the user manual for step-by-step instructions.

1. Import the XML file contained in the DemoData folder.
2. Use the one-click "Import Demo Data" button in JustLanded's user interface (Home → Backup and Import → Import Demo Data) to also import the landing page settings.
3. Select the header and footer menus via Appearance → Menus.
4. Select one of the example landing pages as your front page (see http://codex.wordpress.org/Creating_a_Static_Front_Page for reference you have never done this before).

If you skip step 4, the blog index page will be your front page and none of the changes you make in the JustLanded options panel will have any effect on the live site.

Imported pages may not have the same page IDs as they do on our demo installation. Therefore, in case you are seeing empty content blocks after using the Import Demo Data button, please assign "Image Left – Content Right" and "Content Left – Video Right" as "Source 1" for Page Content Blocks 1 & 2 respectively to ensure that you are seeing a 1:1 copy of the original demo site. (JustLanded panel -> Page Content).

If you would like to use the Contact Form 7 plug-in as we do on our demo site, please ensure this plug-in is present and active during the XML import. If it is not present, you will see an error message indicating that contact forms could not be imported. You can safely ignore the message as everything else will nevertheless be imported.

Landing Pages

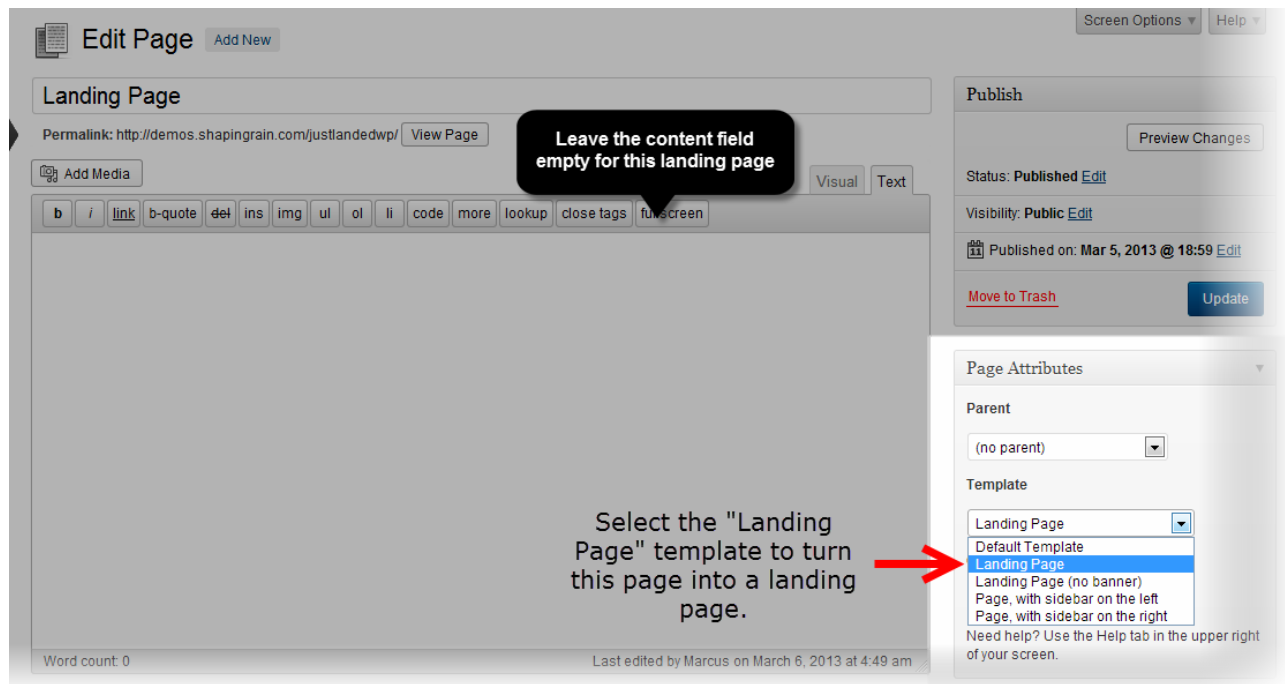
If you are not using the demo data, you may wish to create a landing page yourself.

Landing Pages are pages that use the 'Landing Page' template. You can create a new landing page in two simple steps:

1. Create a new page.
2. Select the Landing Page template.

You can leave the large text area containing your content empty, as contents will be retrieved from the JustLanded options panel.

Selection of the 'Landing Page' template instructs the theme to display this page as a landing page.

Please read about the Profiles feature in the user manual. Whenever you select a different settings profile, please be aware that settings will only be saved into this active profile and you will see your changes only on landing pages that actually use that profile.
